Ozark Mills

Willow Springs and the Missouri Ozarks are blessed with scenic beauty that you likely won't be able to top, no matter how much you travel. Nestled in the beautiful Ozarks countryside are numerous old-time flour and gristmills, which at one time were the center of life, the heart of small communities peppered throughout the region.

Hodgson Mill

From the parking lot on Highway 181 where it crosses Bryant Creek, you can feel the cool breeze from the natural air conditioning provided by the spring under Hodgson Mill. The spring pumps about 24 to 28 million gallons of cold, clear water each day into Bryant Creek. A mill had been on site since the 1830's, with the second mill burning down during the Civil War.

Dawt Mill

The mill and resort are located off Highway PP on the North Fork River and have long been a popular spot for canoeing and fishing. The water is clear and calls visitors to the mill and general store, where you can find Dawt Mill souvenirs, river necessities, and a cold drink. Canoeing is available between March and November; convention facilities and rooms also are available.

Rockbridge Mill

Traveling along Highway 76, go west to Highway 95, then south to Highway N, then just up the road to Rockbridge. Learn more about Rockbridge by visiting them online at www.rockbridgemo.com

Topaz Mill

Located in Douglas County, off Highway E south of the junction of Highway 76 and 181, Topaz Mill is privately owned; however, the owners are friendly and welcome visitors to the property.

Area golfers know that the Willow Springs Thomas F. Benyo Municipal Golf Course is synonymous with nearly flawless bent grass greens, zoysia tee boxes, improved watered fairways and the best layout of any area course. With 5 sets of tees to handle any skill level from Junior beginner to the low handicapper, all golfers can find happiness at this 9-hole venue.

Couple that with the lowest area membership dues and green fees, and Willow Springs truly is the golfing gem of the Ozarks.



The course features two lakes that figure prominently on several holes, a dozen sand traps that demand precision shooting, and enough trees to make a lumberjack feel at home.



For a golf experience that is both a challenge and yet economical, you can't go wrong at Willow Springs Thomas F. Benyo Municipal Golf Course. You can find us just north of downtown Willow Springs on Highway 137. The golf course appreciates the support of the community and, as always, will strive to provide a top-notch golf experience.

Willow Springs Senior Housing, also known as Sunshine Village, is located at 700 East 6th Street. The 108 apartments include 90 single-bedroom and 18 double-bedroom apartments. Each unit has 4 apartments with a patio area and sidewalks leading to the recreation hall and laundry. To be eligible to enjoy living here, you must be at least 62 years old or physically disabled. All utilities are included in the monthly rent.

The Willow Springs Senior Center is located on Senior Center Drive, conveniently adjacent to Senior Housing. It serves many social functions such as dances, exercise classes, painting, and fellowship. Affordable meals are served Monday through Friday for anyone wishing to enjoy them.



The Willow Springs R-IV School District is a public-school district serving 1300+ students in an area of 310 square miles located primarily in Howell County with portions of the district in Douglas and Texas counties. The district owns many facilities on the various campuses, all for the purpose of providing high quality education to students enrolled in Pre-K through grade 12. The Willow Springs High School was established in 1894 with the first graduation held in 1895. The campus is located on Ferguson Street and stretches from Fourth to Tenth streets. The average experience for teachers in the district is 14 years. Fifty-eight percent of the teachers in the district have a master's degree or higher. The ratio of students per classroom teacher is 16:1.


